





START SMART IN YOUR CITY

We would like the next Start Smart Host City to work with the Start Smart team to deliver a project that is unique to that city but that meets the following criteria:

- To deliver a programme of activity in the city that inspires the community and builds and expands on local initiatives focused on health and nutrition for the under-fives
- To build lasting relationships with families in the city, through participation in events, community engagement and reaching out to sectors of the community who are disenfranchised and isolated
- To create a demonstrable impact from the programme, through activities in the community
- To demonstrate a clear approach to maximising the legacy and evaluating the impacts from Start Smart

YOUR PROPOSAL

We will welcome bid proposals from teams in cities across the UK that would like to bring Start Smart to their city, work in partnership on an exciting and meaningful project and who come forward with plans for how we might work together.

These plans should be:

- Innovative and representative of the area – building on what your city has to offer and how it can benefit from working in partnership with Start Smart
- Ambitious, with the potential to create a lasting step change in the area;
- Include a suggestion of local and regional players that can play a part in Start Smart
- Inclusive of a wide range of audiences and participants, especially families with children under the age of five and those 'hard to reach' communities
- Realistic, affordable and deliverable

Start Smart is requesting proposal from bid teams that should include:

- **A CITY OVERVIEW** – what is the current context around childhood health in your city, what programmes are currently run in the city that focus on improving health and nutrition. Any relevant demographic or supporting information.
- **YOUR PLANS** – your ideas and approach to how Start Smart will run in your city
- **KEY TEAM MEMBERS** – suggested project team and suggested network of influencers and local organisations
- **THE PARTNERSHIP** – why you would like to work with us to bring Start Smart to your city





WHAT YOU GET

As a Start Smart City you will receive a Start Smart project toolkit, which you can use as a guide to hosting the project and which will include support from the Start Smart team. This will be based upon a tried and tested blueprint and which you are able to adapt for your own city.

The Start Smart team will be on hand to facilitate the delivery of the project, to maximize the impact and profile of your work and to introduce national partner organisations where appropriate.
